OBJECTIVES

- 1. Learn whether influenza and RSV are similar in terms of severity and cost in hospitalized children.
- Recognize the impact of LRTI/RSV disease in infants who did not receive prophylaxis in Quebec following withdrawal of this indication.
- 3. Appreciate the magnitude of antibiotic use in bronchiolitis after national recommendations against routine prescribing. What is the way forward?
- 4. Learn the indications for RSV prophylaxis in Nunavik. Has this altered the landscape of RSV infection?
- 5. Recognize the burden of RSV hospitalization on children and families, an often forgotten entity.
- 6. Appreciate that with viral swabs, it is not good enough to "do" just because we "can."
- 7. Learn about new multiplex diagnostic platforms and tests for RSV with a quick turnaround time. Are they applicable as point-of-care in everyday practice?
- 8. Learn the importance of careful, stepwise, assessment of RSV infection and the implications of a missed diagnosis.
- Changes for the 2019–2020 season: New materials and recent experiences shared by all participants with the OPDP program.


