

OBJECTIVES

1. Learn whether influenza and RSV are similar in terms of severity and cost in hospitalized children.
2. Recognize the impact of LRTI/RSV disease in infants who did not receive prophylaxis in Quebec following withdrawal of this indication.
3. Appreciate the magnitude of antibiotic use in bronchiolitis after national recommendations against routine prescribing. What is the way forward?
4. Learn the indications for RSV prophylaxis in Nunavik. Has this altered the landscape of RSV infection?
5. Recognize the burden of RSV hospitalization on children and families, an often forgotten entity.
6. Appreciate that with viral swabs, it is not good enough to "do" just because we "can."
7. Learn about new multiplex diagnostic platforms and tests for RSV with a quick turnaround time. Are they applicable as point-of-care in everyday practice?
8. Learn the importance of careful, stepwise, assessment of RSV infection and the implications of a missed diagnosis.
9. Changes for the 2019–2020 season: New materials and recent experiences shared by all participants with the OPDP program.

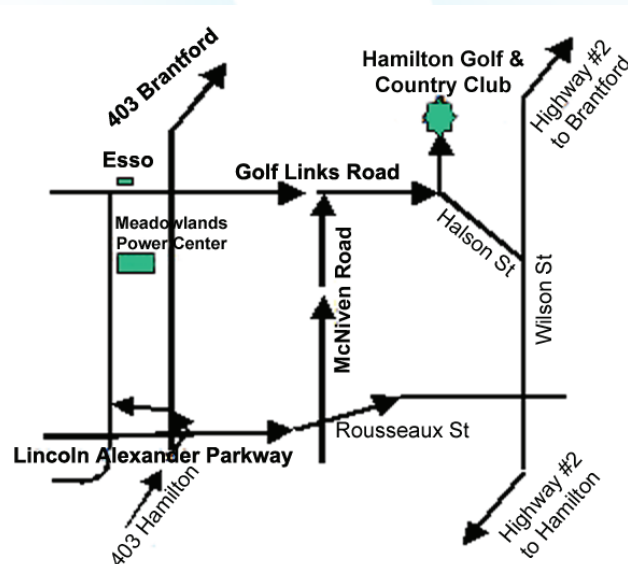
